

**Caroline Maud Marsh**  
**(d. 12.2.1899)**

**Actress**

Born in London as Caroline Maude Foster, she made her name on the American stage.

Her husband Richard Marsh was the son of a noted English Shakespearean actor, Henry Marston (real name Richard Henry Marsh).

After starting a career as a performer, Richard moved to America where he became a well-known set designer and presumably met his wife.

Caroline died in New York and it is possible that Richard was intending to return home to England, hence her burial in London. He was living in Tufnell Park at the time but later went back to the USA, where he died in 1917.

The epitaph is by American poet Fitz-Greene Halleck, taken from his Ode on the Death of Joseph Rodman Drake.
